



GHANA STANDARDS BOARD GHANA STANDARD ON SUYA (KHEBAB) POWDER

The Ghana Standards Board is pleased to announce the publication of the national standard on Suya (Khebab) powder:

- ***GS 876: 2009 - Spices and Condiments – Specification for Suya (Khebab) Powder.***

The Standard specifies the requirements for suya (Khebab) powder as flavouring for grilled meat and poultry and is intended for human consumption. The Standard also establishes the essential requirements for suya (khebab) powder

The Standard provides the following information:

- Adulteration - The addition of unapproved substances to suya (khebab) powder.
- Raw material requirements which state that the groundnuts should be mature, sound, free from rots and other diseases, insect infestations and other contaminants such as heavy metals.
- Other requirements for packaging, labeling, sampling, testing and criteria for conformity assessment are also indicated.
