The Ghana Standard Board is pleased to announce the publication of a National Standard for *soy flour*.

➤ ***GS 879:2009 Cereals, Pulses and Legumes-Specification for Soy Flour.***

The standard applies to soy flour obtained from the processing of soybeans (*Glycine max L*) and is intended for human consumption.

The standard seeks to answer questions such as:

- *What are the types of soy flour?*
- *What are the characteristics of quality soy flour and the microbiological requirement?*
- *What type of raw material to use and its requirement for the processing of soy flour?*
- *What are the safety measures to be carried out in processing and packaging of soy flour as well as labeling of the product?*



Local manufacturers, Importers and processors of soy flour are encouraged to comply with the requirements of the new standard.
